I would suggest to adapt all verbs in the case description and in some sentences.

Please pay also attention to the consonants (“ceftazidime of cefotaxime” should be changed to “ceftazidime or cefotaxime”).

References should be made uniform.

After these minor changes the paper could be accepted for publication.
