Reviewer Comments: In general, the English is poor. The study warrants a figure. A PET figure would make this paper attractive to readers.

1. Page 3, paragraph 2: “fed” not “feeded”; comma after “daily”, “in the laboratory of Dr. Antoni van Leeuwenhoek (Netherlands Cancer Institute)”, “imaging by positron emission tomography-computed tomography (PET-CT) after two months of treatment revealed tumor response”

2. How was tumor response measured? Can you show pre and post PET figures?

3. Page 4, paragraph 2: remove “once” and place a comma after “daily”, affected not effected (what does “relevant” manner mean?), systemic not “systematic”, remove first “supplements” and change “nor” for “or”.
4. Page 5, paragraph 1: remove “either”, “it is important to minimize the exposure of crizotinib” (what are handles?), again remove “either”,
